Approved applicants will be notified by mail of the exact date, time and place of the examination at least five (5) days prior to the examination date, which will be held in Plaquemine, Louisiana.

Qualification Requirements:

- Unless otherwise specified, applicant's qualification requirements must be met when filing by the deadline for application for admission to the examination.
- Must meet all requirements of the Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Law, including being a citizen of the United States.
- After an offer of employment, but before beginning work in this class, applicant must pass a physical examination, the selection and administration of which will be authorized by the Appointing Authority (City of Plaquemine) designed to demonstrate good health and physical fitness sufficient to perform the essential duties of the position, with or without accommodation.
- Must have a high school diploma or a valid equivalency issued by a state department of education.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Prior to beginning work in this class, must obtain and maintain a valid Louisiana driver's license.
- Must be not less than eighteen (18) years of age.
