Iberville Friends of the Arts Art Discipline Descriptions

While the Iberville Friends of the Arts is not limited to those who recognize themselves as artist, or artistic individuals, we wish to establish a database of artists, art lovers and supporting organizations/businesses. The goal of the Iberville Friends of the Arts is to establish an organization that supports and encourages Iberville Parish artists, art lovers, and organizations that would create a cultural economy. For the purposes of the database only, some artistic disciplines are presently listed; however additional disciplines will be added.

Descriptions

Friends of the Arts

Individuals and organizations/businesses who wish to help assist the arts. If you wish to volunteer or become a part of the Iberville Friends of the Arts, please add that request to the “additional information” section.

Dance

A discipline of the arts that generally involves the body, often in movement. The various styles listed under the dance discipline are: Ballet, Ethnic/Jazz, Modern/Contemporary, Folk/ Traditional. Ballet dancers would include individuals who adhere to the classical dance forms. Ethnic/Jazz dancers would include styles of dance with African roots. Modern/Contemporary dancers would utilize their whole body movement with little or no adherence for classical dance forms. Folk/Traditional dancers would include individuals who express cultural and historical dances.

Design

A discipline that includes architecture, urban design, historic preservation and planning, interior design, industrial design, graphic design, and fashion design. May include businesses or organizations that produce publications, audio visual presentations or conferences.

Food

A discipline of the arts that uses the preparation of food to stimulate taste, smell and visual sensory.

Literature

The discipline includes both individuals and the businesses that create and publish (small or large presses and magazines) all forms of writing and oral literature. This also includes creative prose or literary criticism. This is open to both published and unpublished writers and oral traditionalists.

Media

This discipline can use film, video, radio, or other related media.

Music

This discipline can include individuals, both trained and untrained, composers, and/or music ensembles and orchestras.

Other

This discipline includes occupational crafts (carpenters, bricklayers, stonemasons, masons, taxidermy, landscaping, et cetera) and those who fall under an additional category not listed. Please make a note in the "additional information" section.

Theatre

This discipline includes both music, traditional, and historical theater.

Visual Arts & Crafts

This includes fine arts, hobbyist, and traditional/folk visual arts. Mixed media is the use of multiple mediums. Public art is art in public places. Conservation art includes both restoration and art to bring awareness to conservation of various aspects of human life.
