ADOPT AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE VI, BY ADDING SECTION 20-465 TO CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE VI OF THE PLAQUEMINE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO PARADES AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO. (PROHIBIT RIDING OF HORSES (EXCEPT BY LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL), THREE-WHEELERS, FOUR-WHEELERS, DIRT/MOTORCYCLE, GO-CARTS, GOLF CARTS, SIDE-BY-SIDE AND 2-SEATER AND 4-SEATER KAWASAKI MULE. MINIATURE CARS (SHRINER’S PARADE CARS) ARE ALLOWED AND LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL MAY USE ANY TYPE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLE TO CONTROL CROWD AND TRAFFIC.)

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE VI, BY ADDING SECTION 20-465 TO CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE VI OF THE PLAQUEMINE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO PARADES AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Selectpersons of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, in legal session, that Code of Ordinances of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, hereby amends Chapter 20, Article VI, by adding Section 20-465, to read as follows:

That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, is hereby amended by adding a Section 20-465, to be numbered 20-465, which said section reads as follows:

CHAPTER 20

ARTICLE VI. PARADES

Sec. 20-465. Prohibited and Permitted Parade Activities, Animals and Vehicles.

- (a) The term animal used in Section 20-457(c)(6) above does not mean or include horse or other members of the equine family.
- (b) Horse(s) or other members of the equine family ridden by one (1) or more persons are not allowed in the parade except horse(s) ridden by law enforcement personnel when used by law enforcement personnel for crowd control and traffic control purposes.
- (c) Three-wheeler and four-wheeler, dirt/motorcycle, go-carts, golf carts, side-by-side and two (2) seater and four (4) seater-four (4) wheel Kawasaki Mule with or without a roll bar housing and like kind vehicles are prohibited vehicles and not allowed in the parade.
- (d) Miniature cars (example - Shriner’s parade cars) are allowed
- (e) Law enforcement personnel may use any type of motorized vehicles in and around the parade route when used for crowd control and traffic control purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Selectmen of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, that this ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Selectmen of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in their entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Selectmen of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, that it is the intention the City that the provisions of this article be construed, enforced and interpreted in such a manner as will cause the least possible infringement of the constitutional rights of free speech, free expression, due process, equal protection or other fundamental rights consistent with the purposes of this article. Should a court of competent jurisdiction determine that any part of this article, or any application or enforcement of it is excessively restrictive of such rights or liberties, then such portion of the article, or specific application of the article, shall be severed from the remainder, which shall continue in full force and effect.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER I, SECTION 1-15 BY INCREASING THE FEE CHARGED FOR CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECKS, ACCIDENT REPORTS AND COMPLAINTS IN CHAPTER I, SECTION 1-15 OF THE PLAQUEMINE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO FEES CHARGED AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Selectmen of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, in legal session, that Code of Ordinances of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, hereby amends Chapter I, Section 1-15, by amended the fee charged for criminal records checks, accident reports and complaints in Chapter I, Section 1-15, to read as follows:

That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, is hereby amended to amend the fee charged in Chapter I, Section 1-15, which said section reads as follows:

CHAPTER I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 1-15. Fee for criminal records checks, accident reports and complaints.

- (a) **The Plaquemine Police Department, through the chief of police, is hereby authorized to charge any person an amount of \$25.00 for the first ten (10) pages and \$1.00 per page thereafter, for copying, administration charges with connection with access to criminal records checks, accident reports, and review of any and all complaints, not subject to the confidentiality requirements as provided by law.**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 19, ARTICLE II, DIVISION I, SECTION 19-16(c) BY ADDING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE TAXPAYER PROVIDE A COPY OF A LOUISIANA DRIVER'S LICENSE OR LOUISIANA STATE ISSUED IDENTIFICATION PRIOR TO CITY ISSUES LICENSE PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 19, ARTICLE II, DIVISION I, SECTION 19-16(c) OF THE PLAQUEMINE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO ISSUING OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Selectpersons of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, in legal session, that Code of Ordinances of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, hereby amends Chapter 19, Article II, Division I, Section 19-16(c), by adding the requirement to provide a copy of taxpayer's Louisiana Driver's license or Louisiana state issued identification prior to city issuing license provided in Chapter 19, Article II, Division I, Section 19-16(c), to read as follows:

That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plaquemine, Louisiana, is hereby amended to amend what is required before occupational license is issue pursuant to Chapter 19, Article II, Division I, Section 19-16(c), which said section reads as follows:

CHAPTER 19
ARTICLE II, LICENSE TAXES
DIVISION I. GENERAL

Sec. 19-16(c). Levy; issuance of license.

(c) Upon payment of the tax due as reflected on the application filed by the taxpayer, the collector shall issue the license applied for. Along with the payment of the tax due, the taxpayer shall provide a copy of taxpayer's Louisiana driver's license or a copy of Louisiana State issue identification. If the taxpayer is a legal entity, the Louisiana driver's license or Louisiana State issue identification provided shall be of one of the officers, managers or members of the legal entity listed with the Louisiana Secretary of State. ... *(Remainder of subsection (c) remained unchanged)*

(b)(4) **Along with the payment of the tax due, the taxpayer shall provide a copy of taxpayer's Louisiana driver's license or a copy of Louisiana State issue identification. If the taxpayer is a legal entity, the Louisiana driver's license or Louisiana State issue identification provided shall be of one of the officers, managers or members of the legal entity listed with the Louisiana Secretary of State.**
